Thinking Skill	Activities
<b>Knowledge</b> (Remember)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write some facts about the world's seven continents and five oceans.</li> </ul>
<b>Comprehension</b> (Understand)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make a list of the seven continents and their oceans.</li> <li>Draw a picture of animals, land features or anything interesting that you have found out about your chosen continent.</li> <li>Write a list of things you would need for this particular continent if you were to travel there.</li> </ul>
<b>Application</b> (Apply)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make a paper plate globe to showcase your knowledge of continents and oceans.</li> </ul>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Draw or paint your own journey or map around the world.</li> </ul>
<b>Analysis</b> (Analyse)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write some questions you might ask a person who lives on these continents, e.g. In Australia – aboriginals.</li> <li>Do you know any famous explorers who have travelled the world and visited these continents?</li> </ul>
<b>Synthesis</b> (Create)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Design and make a model/structure of a landmark that is part of your chosen continent.</li> </ul>
<b>Evaluation</b> (Evaluate)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write a postcard home from an animal/person that lives in one of the following areas– a dry (desert), coastal (local) or rainforest area.</li> </ul>
