Level of thinking	Skills
Knowledge	Knowledge and recall of information and facts. For example: List, label, name, define.
Comprehension	Understanding and interpreting information and facts. For example: Explain, summarise, reward, describe.
Application	Using information and exploring meaning. For example: Use, demonstrate, how, solve, apply.
Analysis	Finding patterns and exploring meaning. For example: Analyse, organise, compare, contrast, group.
Synthesis	Predicting, creating new ideas and conclusions from learning. For example: Create, design, predict, invent. Develop.
Evaluation	Comparing, making choice and deciding how useful something is. For example: Judge, recommend, justify.
