They all had a great time competing, showed great team spirit and came 6th which is an amazing achievement!



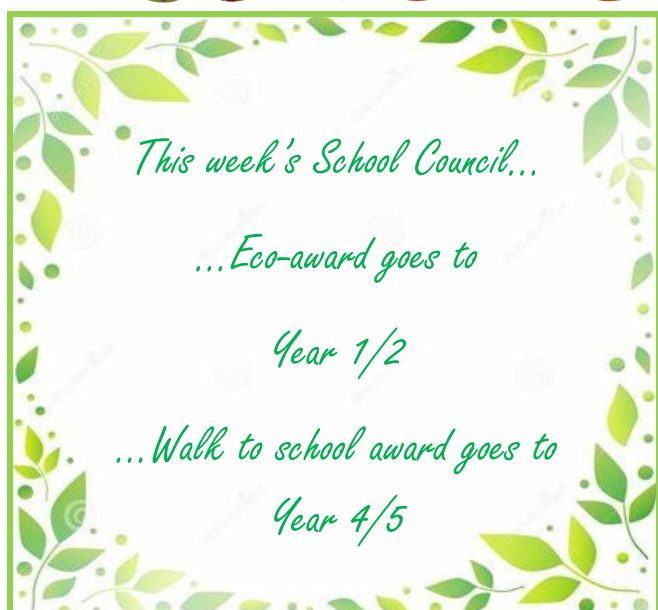
FAMILY EASTER EGG BINGO: THURSDAY 21ST MARCH

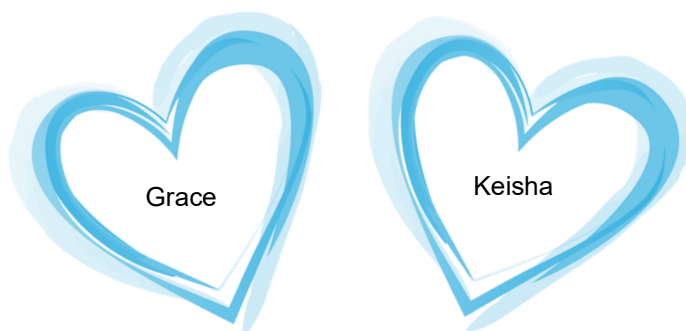


EASTER CELEBRATION

This programme will explore the 8 sensory systems and how the environment can impact on Autistic individuals.
