Communication and Language

Literacy

Letters and sounds – Phase 2/3

How you can help at home:

- Regularly reading with your child (Lilac/Pink/Red books)
- Practising reading high frequency words
- Practising writing high frequency words
- Practising counting forwards and backwards to at least 20
- Practising dressing and undressing

Mathematical Development

Using mathematical names for 2D shapes
Using shapes and objects to create patterns and models
Using everyday language related to money
Comparing two sets of objects using 'more' and 'fewer'
Finding the total amount in two groups
Saying what is one more than a given number
Finding one more or one less from a group of up to 5 objects
Beginning to use addition and subtraction vocabulary
