SPORTS FUNDING AND HOW IT IS ALLOCATED - £9200

At St Vincent's, we are committed to raising the profile of every child's physical education. We are proud to offer high quality PE lessons through the use of upskilled school staff, as well as high quality coaches. This ensures continuity and progression throughout both key stages, as well as each child receiving a minimum of two hours physical activity every week. Children in Y2, Y4 and Y6 go on outdoor and adventure residentials and visits. They also take part in competitions both within and beyond the school. The Sports Fund has allowed us to improve the quality of provision and equipment throughout the school. The impact has been positive for all pupils and has allowed more pupils to access a wide range of opportunities. School has also been successful in securing additional Lottery funding to develop the outside area to improve access to physical development opportunities for FS and KS1 pupils.
