Thinking Skill	Activities
Knowledge (Remember)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write some facts about the planets or space.
Comprehension (Understand)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draw a picture of the solar system.• Write a list of things you would need if you were to travel to the moon.
Application (Apply)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make a space shuttle or a machine which would carry you to the moon.• Draw or paint your own alien or fairy who you met whilst you were in space.• Can you grow your own plant from a seed and write a list of instructions about its growth.
Analysis (Analyse)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write some questions you might ask a person who lives on another planet.• Do you know any famous astronauts or people who have travelled to space? Research them.• Research a famous explorer who has travelled the world.
Synthesis (Create)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Design and make a model of a space shuttle you would journey to space in.• Design a cardboard house in which you would live whilst in space and things you would need inside.
Evaluation (Evaluate)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write a postcard home from space describing your day.• Can plants survive in space? Why not?
