## Theme: Treasure Island – links with Science – plants, animals and materials.



You can complete as many of the tasks as you choose in the time given, but you must make sure that it is well presented work to share or display and show off your skills!

Thinking Skill	Activities
<b>Knowledge</b> (Remember)	<ul> <li>Write some facts about the plants or animals that live on or around your island.</li> </ul>
<b>Comprehension</b> (Understand)	<ul> <li>Make a list of food you might get to eat on your island.</li> <li>Write some instructions to find the treasure. (Use a teabag to stain the paper beforehand to make them look old.)</li> </ul>
Application (Apply)	<ul> <li>Make a treasure map with different areas on the island such as a swamp or a forest.</li> <li>Draw or paint a treasure chest with some treasure inside.</li> </ul>
<b>Analysis</b> (Analyse)	<ul> <li>Write some questions you might ask a person who has been stranded on an island.</li> </ul>
<b>Synthesis</b> (Create)	<ul> <li>Design and make a simple shelter that you might build to protect yourself from the sun or rain.</li> </ul>
<b>Evaluation</b> (Evaluate)	<ul> <li>Write a message in a bottle asking for helping.</li> <li>Write a short pirate story. Will your main character be good or bad?</li> </ul>
