Brasilia is the capital city of Brazil. It was founded in 1960 in a plan to move the capital from Rio de Janeiro to a more central location.

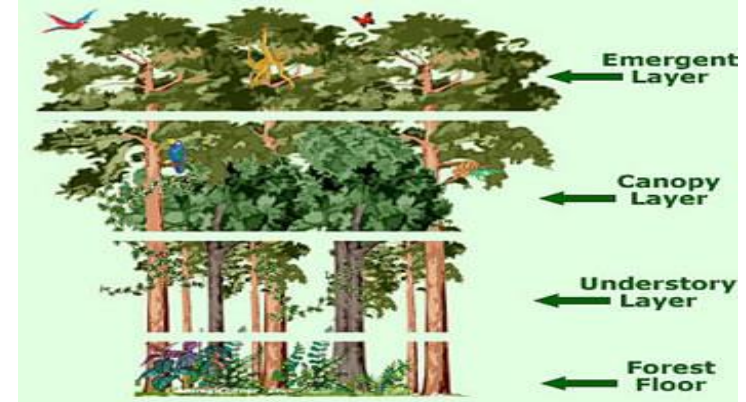


Key Knowledge: Human and Physical features of Brazil.

Continents - Large mass of land. **Atlas/globe** - displays a map of the Earth. **Population** - how many people live in a place. **Favela** - name for several types of working-class neighbourhoods in Brazil. **Climate** - the average weather in a given area. **Amazon Rain Forest** - tropical rainforest in the Amazon. **Human** - built by humans. **Physical** - Natural features of land- trees, cliffs etc.
