

In this unit we will continue with John's Gospel. We learn that Christians believe that Jesus rose from the dead, and that all Christians are called to witness to the Resurrection by the example of their new life in baptism, strengthened by the Holy Spirit in confirmation.

In John's Gospel, Jesus gifts the disciples with the Holy Spirit. Just as God breathed life into Adam, Jesus breathes new life in the disciples.



Adam	The name given in Genesis 1-5 to the first human. Adam is the first human-being aware of God.
Mary Magdala	A woman who, according to the gospels, travelled with Jesus and was a witness to his crucifixion and resurrection.
Resurrection	Through resurrection, Christians believe life has triumphed over death, good over evil, hope over despair. The resurrection is a sign of God's great power.
Martyr	A person who is killed because of their religious or other beliefs.
Witness	A witness is someone who sees something important or amazing.
Saint	A person who is recognised as having an exceptional degree of holiness, likeness, or closeness to God.
Charity	Generosity and helpfulness towards the needs of others.




