Key Artists: George Seurat



Investigate (style / techniques / examples):

- To find out who Georges Seurat was and explore his style of art.
- To explore how to create art in the style of pointillism.
- To explore how Seurat used colours in his artwork.
- To explore Seurat's paintings and how he created effects and shading.
- To explore how to draw a self portrait.
- To be able to create and evaluate a piece of pointillism artwork.

Design and Create:

In the final outcome the children will draw a self portraits using paints, inspired by the pointillism techniques and work of George Seurat.









Evaluate:

To use their sketch books to record their observations and use them to review and revisit ideas.

Evaluate a piece of work, reflecting upon the media used.

Peer/ self assessment of each other's work against the success criteria.
