#### Key Artists: L S Lowry

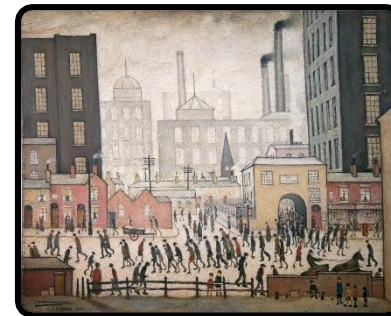


#### Investigate (style / techniques / examples):
