

## <u>Key Vocabulary</u>: <u>Maiden Voyage</u> - The first journey of a ship. Transatlantic- Crossing the Atlantic.

<u>**Passenger**</u> - A person who is traveling in an car, bus, train, airplane or ship.

<u>**Iceberg**</u>-A large floating mass of ice detached from a glacier or ice sheet and floats in the sea.

<u>Survivor</u> - A person who remains alive after an event in which others have died.

Bow- The front section of a ship.

<u>Starboard</u> - The right-hand side of a ship.

Hull- The main body of a ship.

<u>Lifeboat</u> - A form of transport that was attached to the boat.

<u>Class</u> - depending on how rich or poor you were, you would be placed on a certain level on the ship.

<u>Carpathia</u> - Boat best known for rescuing the survivors of the Titanic.

Unsinkable - Can not be sunk.
