Key Vocabulary

Monarch - a person who reigns over a kingdom or empire.

Monarchy - the royal family of a country.

<u>Coronation</u>- the ceremony of crowning.

<u>Heir-</u> a person who is legally entitled to inherit the throne.

<u>Throne</u> - the special chair used by a ruler.

<u>Significant</u> – special and important.

<u>Reigning</u> - the person ruling the throne.

<u>Past heir</u> reigned before. <u>Present heir</u> reigning now. <u>Future</u> - heir reigning next.
