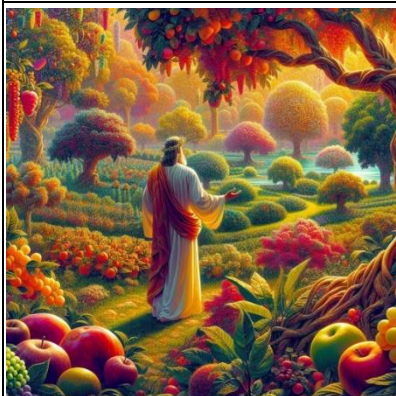




Hear, Believe, Celebrate, Live



Genesis 2: 5-10, 15-23, 3:1-7, 9-13, 17-19)

The Lord God made Man. He then made plants, trees, animals and birds. From Man's rib he made a woman. The woman was then tempted by the snake, who persuaded her to take some fruit from the tree of knowledge and eat it. She gave some to her husband, and he ate it also. They were given understanding and realised that they were naked. They covered themselves with fig leaves.

John 1:1-5, 16-18

We write to you about the Word of life, which has existed from the very beginning. We have heard it, and we have seen it with our eyes; yes, we have seen it and our hands have touched it. When this life became visible, we saw it; so we speak of it and tell you about the eternal life which was with the Father and was made known to us. What we have seen and heard we announce to you also, so that you will join with us in the fellowship that we have with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ. We write this in order that our joy may be complete.

Everything that belongs to the world - what the sinful desires, what people see and want, and everything in this world that people are so proud of - none of this comes from the Father; it all comes from the world. The world and everything in it that people desire is passing away; but those who do the will of God live forever.
