Adjectives in Spanish need to agree in gender and number with the noun they are describing.

- La ciudad es pequeña. (The city is small.)
- El pueblo es pequeño. (The village is small.)
- La ciudad es tranquila. (The city is quiet.)
- El pueblo es tranquilo. (The village is quiet.)
