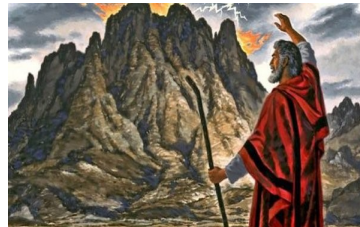

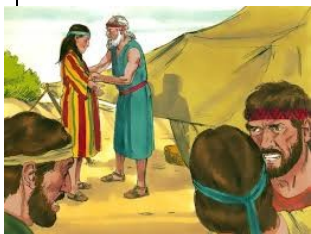


Exodus 3 1-15 Mount Sinai

Then Moses went up on the mountain to God. The Lord called to him from the mountain. The Lord said, "Say this to the family of Jacob. And tell this to the people of Israel: 'Every one of you has seen what I did to the people of Egypt. You saw how I carried you out of Egypt. I did it as an eagle carries her young on her wings. And I brought you here to me. So now obey me and keep my agreement. You must tell the Israelites these words.'"



And God spoke all these words: I am the Lord your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt. You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

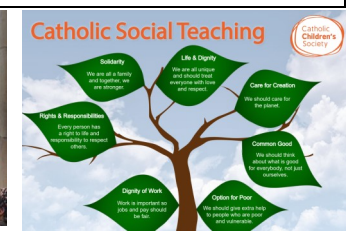

Moses

Moses is known primarily for **being a prophet**. In the Old Testament, Moses encounters God in a burning bush, which leads him to help the Israelites escape from slavery in Egypt. Moses then receives the Ten Commandments

Exodus

The liberation of the people of Israel from slavery in Egypt, under the leadership of Moses; also, the Old Testament book

Sinai

A peninsula in Egypt

Commandments

Ten commandments are religious and ethical directives structured as a covenant given to Moses by God

virtues

A behaviour showing moral values

grace

God's grace is usually defined as undeserved favour. Grace cannot be earned; it is something that is freely given.
