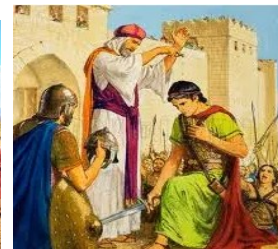

| Samuel    | Samuel was the prophet who would anoint David as King of Israel                                                                                    |
| David     | David was the second ruler of ancient Israel and Judah. He founded the Judaean dynasty and united all the tribes of Israel under a single monarch. |
| anointing | Anointing is the ritual act of pouring aromatic oil over a person's head or entire body.                                                           |
| antiphon  | Antiphons are passages (usually from Scripture) meant to be sung before and after verses from the Psalms or canticles of Holy Scripture.           |
| psalm     | A sacred song or poem                                                                                                                              |
| Advent    | The period of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ at Christmas                                                            |

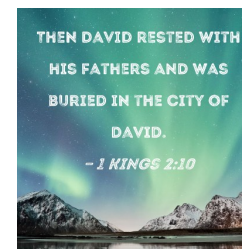
