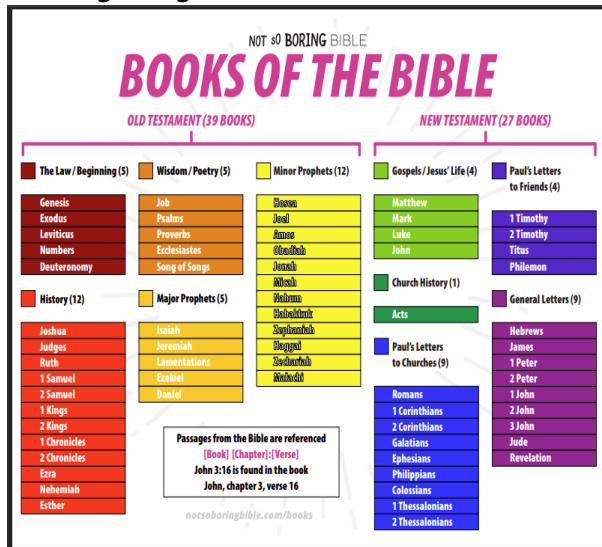

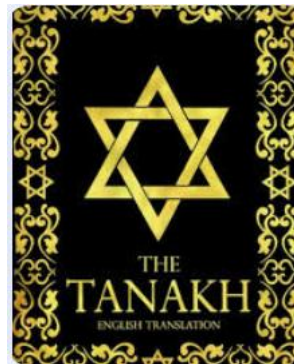
### The Lords Covenant with Abram

Old Testament	The Old Testament (OT) is the first division of the Christian biblical canon, which is based primarily upon the 24 books of the Hebrew Bible, or Tanakh
New testament,	The New Testament is a collection of 27 Christian texts written in Greek by various authors, forming the second major division of the Christian Bible.
Bible	The Bible is a collection of religious texts that are central to Christianity and Judaism
Tanakh,	The Hebrew Bible or Tanakh, also known in Hebrew as Miqra, is the canonical collection of Hebrew scriptures, comprising the Torah, the Nevi'im, and the Ketuvim.
Shema,	The Shema is a foundational prayer in Judaism, expressing the belief in one God. It's recited multiple times a day.
Mezuzah	A mezuzah is a small container, typically attached to the doorpost of Jewish homes, containing a small scroll inscribed with biblical verses, primarily the Shema prayer.
