Theme: –Where does our food come from?

You can complete as many of the tasks as you choose in the time given, but you must make sure that it is well presented work to share or display and show off your skills!

Thinking Skill	Activities
Knowledge (Remember)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write some facts about food from countries around the world.• Chose a plant and write some interesting facts about it.• Draw and label the diagram of a plant or flower.
Comprehension (Understand)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Using a map can you plot where different foods from around the world come from.• Draw or paint your own picture of a flower or plant.• Can you grow your own plant from a seed and write a list of instructions about its growth.
Application (Apply)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write some questions you might ask someone who makes certain foods – butchers, bakers, farmer etc.• Keep a food diary for a week that shows the plants that you have been eating and the parts that they come from? If you eat meat, which animal does the meat you eat come from?• Draw a picture of what you see in the garden and trees. Use paint, chalk, felt tips, pencils or crayons.
Analysis (Analyse)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do you know any famous chefs? Research them.• Look around your house and see how many things you can find that are made from trees or plants. Draw the things you find and label them. Extra challenge: Can you find out how a few of the things you found were made?
Synthesis (Create)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create a bar, tally or pictogram to show the growth of your plant or flower.• Create a menu from a restaurant around the world – France, Italy, Spain, Germany etc- what do they eat there.• Can you create your own recipe and write a set of instructions?
Evaluation (Evaluate)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write a postcard home as if you were an insect or animal living amongst the plants. What did you see, hear, smell and feel.
