#### Literacy

**Books** – Traditional stories 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' Fairy tales- sleeping Beauty, Rapunzel, Cinderella, Aladdin. Children will watch a pantomime of Aladdin in school

Letters and sounds – continuing Phase 3 (+ reviewing Phase 2)

Reading – high frequency words/tricky words/home readers Guided reading – Pink/Red level Segmenting and blending cvc/cvcc words Writing simple sentences and captions.

**Real PE** – Unit 3 Tilly The Trains Big Day – dynamic balance on a line

Thembi walks the tightrope – static balance – stance Fairytale dancing

Roleplaying Billy Goats Gruff in outdoor area

#### **Understanding the World**

New year. Making new year resolutions/promises Chinese New Year: performing Chinese new year parade . making Chinese lanterns. Writing Chinese calligraphy Valentine's Day

Computing: interacting with a simple program on a computer (linked to traditional stories)

#### How you can help at home:

- Regularly reading with your child (Pink/Red books)
- Practising **reading** Phase 2 and 3 high frequency words
- Practising **writing** Phase 2 and 3 high frequency words
- Practising counting forwards and backwards to at least 20
- Practising recognising and writing numbers 0-20
