Theme: Where would you like to live, Warrington, Formby or Daintree rainforest?

You can complete as many of the tasks as you choose in the time given, but you must make sure that it is well presented work to share or display and show off your skills!

Thinking Skill	Activities
Knowledge (Remember)	 Write about an interesting building or place such as Fiddler's Ferry. Make up a simple quiz about our area. Research Warrington, Formby or Daintree rainforest and write some facts about the area.
Comprehension (Understand)	 Draw a plan or picture map of the route from your house to the park, or to school. Draw a map of how you could get to Formb from here. Draw a map of how you could travel to Daintree Rainforest.
Application (Apply)	 Make a model of a local place or building such as St. Joseph's Church, Fiddler's Ferry or the Town Hall.
Analysis (Analyse)	 Draw a plan of a nearby road with different buildings on it. Design a key to identify each building.
Synthesis (Create)	 How could you improve our area? Sketch a picture of a new place you would like to see, write some reasons why you would like to see the changes. E.g. an ice rink, a beach. Design a new park with some more activities in it. Draw, paint or make a model of your park.
Evaluation (Evaluate)	 Write a 'Welcome to Warrington' poster or leaflet encouraging people to visit or live here.
