Communication and Language

Literacy

Letters and sounds – Phase 4 (plus booster groups)
Reading – high frequency words/tricky words/home readers
Segmenting and blending cvc/cvcc words

Reading for pleasure, information and comprehension skills Independently writing simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others.

Focus on letter size and letter formation.

Travel agents and airport role play area.
