## **EUCHARIST - RELATING** **Memorial Sacrifice**



In this topic we explore how memories are kept alive. We then learn about the Eucharist as a memorial sacrifice. We learn that it is a memorial of Christ's sacrifice on the Cross, through which Christ gives his body and blood for the salvation of all people and provides hope for the future.

**Big Question: Is it important to keep memories alive?**
