Thinking Skill	Activities
Knowledge (Remember)	 List some interesting facts about seahorses. Draw and label the body parts of a seahorse. Can you write about one of the Seven Wonders of the World.
Comprehension (Understand)	 Draw a picture or plan of a seahorse's habitat. Explain the lifecycle of seahorse in pictures or writing. Can you write about the dangers to marine life and the oceans.
Application (Apply)	 Imagine you are on a seahorse adventure in their habitat, write a postcard home about the exciting things you have seen and done.
Analysis (Analyse)	 Draw some other sea creatures who may be a threat to the habitat.
Synthesis (Create)	 Design and construct the habitat of a seahorse inside a shoebox. Make up your own seahorse adventure story. Create a model of one of the seven wonders. Design your own underwater sea creature. Create an underwater collage.
Evaluation (Evaluate)	 Design a poster or leaflet encouraging people to look after a seahorses' habitat.
