## SCHOOL UNIFORM

This year, whilst expecting children to be wearing uniform, we have been understanding of some variation to our uniform due to difficulties created by lockdowns and restrictions.

From September our expectation is that children will wear full school uniform to the high standard expected. When updating uniform ready for September, please ensure that children are wearing uniform as listed below, without variation.

### **Winter Uniform:**

Pale Blue Shirt or Blouse & Tie

Grey Trousers with grey socks

or

Navy pinafore or skirt with navy socks or tights

Navy v-neck Sweatshirt or Cardigan (*School Logo optional*)

Sensible Shoes (Black - ***Not Trainers or Boots***)

### **Summer Uniform:**

Pale Blue Polo Shirt (*School Logo optional*)

Grey Trousers or Shorts with grey socks

or

Pale Blue gingham dress with white socks

Navy v-neck Sweatshirt or Cardigan (*School Logo optional*)

Navy cap (*School Logo optional*)

### **PE Kit**

Pale Blue Polo Shirt (*School Logo optional*) as for uniform above

Navy Sweatshirt or Cardigan as for uniform above (*School Logo optional*)

Navy Shorts or Joggers / leggings

Trainers

Hair bobbles: navy / black / grey / white / blue gingham in summer

No jewellery is to be worn, except for a simple watch. We advise that earrings are not worn for health and safety reasons, however should you allow your child to wear earrings, only small studs will be acceptable, which must be removed for PE.

Hair styles must not be extreme, and should be appropriate and safe for school activities.

BOOK BAGS ONLY until Y6 when a small rucksack can be brought into school.
