# THE MAGIC PORRIDGE POT READING COMPREHENSION - STANDARD Qs

#### Question One (2 Marks)

# 1 mark for each of the following points:

It was run down/shabby it doesn't look new or modern.

# Question Two (3 Marks)

1 mark for each of the following impressions (2 marks). Award 1 mark for an appropriate piece of evidence which supports one impression.

Impression – she was caring.

Evidence – she saw the girl was said and asked her what the matter was.

Impression – she was kind/generous/helpful.

Evidence – she gave her the porridge pot and showed her how to use it.

# **Question Three (1 Mark)**

# 1 mark for a relevant explanation

E.g. Because she thought it was too good to be true.

#### **Question Four (2 Marks)**

#### 1 mark for a simple explanation

E.g. Because she knew her daughter was just trying to help.

### 2 marks for a more developed response

E.g. Because she knew her daughter was trying to be helpful but they didn't any food to put in it and didn't want to seem ungrateful.

#### **Question Five (1 Mark)**

# 1 mark identifying the correct sentence

Erika and her mother laughed and cried with joy.

#### Question Six (1 Mark)

# 1 mark for a relevant explanation

E.g. To emphasise how much porridge came out.

To show that the porridge didn't stop.

# **Question Seven (1 Mark)**

# 1 mark for correctly ordering all events

Erika's mother took the pot for granted – 5 Villagers struggled to find food – 1 Erika and her mother were relieved – 4 An old lady offered a solution – 3 Erika ventured into the forest – 2

# **Question Eight (1 Mark)**

1 mark for ticking the correct answer anxious

# **Question Nine (1 Mark)**

#### 1 mark for all three correct answers

The soil was insufficient for growing crops – **true**Erika confided in the old lady – **true**Erika's mother had lots of energy – **false** 

# Question Ten (2 Marks)

# 1 mark for a simple response

E.g. I think Erika will return and get the pot to stop cooking.

# 2 marks for a more developed response with reference to the text

E.g. I think Erika will return and command the pot to stop but will be angry with her mother/everyone will eat porridge for days.

I think Erika's mother will ask her what the magic words are and apologise as she didn't wait for Erika to return home.
