How you can help at home:

- Practising reading high frequency words
- Practising writing high frequency words
- Practising counting forwards and backwards to at least 10
- Practising dressing and undressing

Mathematical Development

Knows that numbers identify how many objects are in a set. Sometimes matches numeral and quantity correctly.

Compares two groups of objects, saying when they have the same number.

Counts an irregular arrangement of up to 10 objects. Estimates how many objects they can see and checks by counting them

Recognises numerals 1-5

Counts objects to 10 and beginning to count beyond 10.
