**NOVEMBER 14,
1948****FIRST CHILD**

Elizabeth gave birth to her first child,
Prince Charles, at Buckingham Palace.
Prince Charles is first in line to the throne.



**JUNE 2, 1953
CORONATION**

Following the death of her father the
previous year, Elizabeth's coronation took
place in Westminster Abbey. She was
crowned Queen Elizabeth II, at age 27.



**JUNE 21, 1982
PRINCE WILLIAM
IS BORN**

Prince William was born to Prince Charles
and Diana, Princess of Wales. Although
William is the Queen's third grandchild,
the line of succession means that he is
second in line to the throne after his father.

6 February, 2022 marked
70 years since Princess
Elizabeth ascended to
the throne, becoming
Queen Elizabeth II.
