REPORTING COVID-19 CASES NEXT WEEK

In line with DfE guidance published last week, we must continue to report any positive COVID-19 cases until Thursday 24th December. If your child receives a positive COVID-19 test result over the weekend or next week up to and included Christmas Eve, you must notify us so that we can take the appropriate action. Please use the following e-mail which will be monitored daily:

office@stvincentsprimary.org

If we are notified of positive cases over the weekend, we are required to contact anyone who has had close contact and inform them that they are to self-isolate. Any positive cases from Monday until Christmas Eve will not result in any close contacts needing to self-isolate as the contact will have been outside the infectious period, however we are still required to report these cases to the Local Authority and Public Health England.

If your child, or a member of your household receives a positive COVID-19 test after Christmas, which will impact on your child returning to school from Tuesday 5th January, please notify us using the above email address on Monday 4th January when staff will be in school for an INSET day. Thank you
