Question One (1 Mark)

1 mark for ticking the correct answer lake

Question Two (2 Marks)

1 mark for identifying an appropriate feeling

E.g. I think the villagers were feeling scared.

2 marks for identifying an appropriate feeling with evidence from the text

E.g. I think that the villagers were afraid because of the dragons deafening, fire-breathing roars and he attacked their homes every day.

Question Three (1 Mark)

1 mark for identifying what the King gave the dragon next.

E.g. The King gave the dragon his gold and sparkling jewellery.

Question Four (1 Mark)

1 mark for circling the correct answer there was lots of noise in the village

Question Five (1 Mark)

1 mark for relevant explanation

E.g. I think George wanted to save the Princess because he was fearless and liked going on adventures.

Question Six (1 Mark)

1 mark for identifying the Princess was feeling sad because she was crying/sobbing

E.g. The Princess was sad because the text says she was sobbing on the muddy bank.

Question Seven (1 Mark)

1 mark showing an understanding of the phrase

E.g. Spear-like tells us that the dragon's teeth are sharp and pointy.



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Question Eight (1 Mark)

1 mark for all boxes ticked correctly.

At the beginning of the story, the dragon was friends with the King - False At the end of the story, there was peace in the village - True George was riding on an elegant, white horse - True George was scared when he saw the dragon - False
