Governor response to phased re-opening of school

St Vincent's school has remained open for the children of key workers and vulnerable children throughout lockdown and will continue to do so. All the staff have worked incredibly hard for these children and in providing online learning resources for children at home. We are very grateful for the staff's dedication and commitment during this national crisis.

Since the Prime Minister announced the gradual return of children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6, the leadership team has liaised closely with local authority advisers to formulate a detailed plan and Risk Assessment to enable children to return to school as safely as possible, when the time is right. Warrington local authority has made the decision for all schools in Warrington to begin re-opening from 8th June.

The plans and Risk Assessment prepared by the leadership team have been shared with governors and the local authority. They are detailed and comprehensive and have taken a great deal of thought, effort and time.

Sensible measures have been put in place to minimise the spread of the virus. It is our 'best endeavour' to try to keep everyone safe.
