Writing outcomes:

I can say out loud what I am going to write about.

I can compose a sentence orally before writing it.

I can re-read what I have written to check that it makes sense.

To leave spaces in between words.

To punctuate some sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, or question mark.

To join clauses using 'and'

Grammar learning:

To link capital letters with lower case letters.

Spelling learning: Phonics- phase 3 and 5 digraphs and trigraphs. To divide words into syllables.

Maths

Learning outcomes:

To sort objects /count objects /represent objects.

To count, read and write forwards from any number 0 to 20.

To count, read and writing backwards from any number 0 to 20.

To count one more/one less. One to one correspondence to start to compare groups.

To compare groups using language such as equal, more/greater, less/fewer

To introduce = , > and < symbols.

To compare numbers.

To order groups of objects - order numbers.

To understand ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd)

To count to and across 100.

Science

Topic: **Who am I? Myself and my senses.**

Learning outcomes: To identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body. To say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

Working scientifically skills: To observe things using simple equipment. To identify and sort different things.

To collect and record data to help answer questions.

Music

Learning outcomes: Hey You!

To explore ways of using our voices expressively.

To develop skills of singing while performing actions.

To develop a sense of steady beat through using movement, body percussion and instruments.

Computing

Learning outcomes: Computer skills

To be able to switch on and close down a computer or Ipad.

To click and drag a mouse or trackpad.

To launch a programme by double clicking.

To save their work in a folder.

To manipulate an application window by moving and resizing it.
