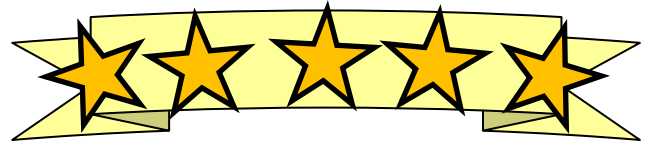
MENTAL HEALTH CHAMPIONS TOP TIP

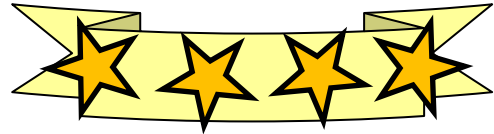
NUT FREE ZONE
