DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

This Sunday is popularly known as 'Mercy of God Sunday'. Between 1930 and 1938 Christ appeared to Sister Faustina (a Sister of Mercy in Poland) who initiated the Divine Mercy devotion. She was canonised on 30th April 2000, the Sunday after Easter, the Feast of the Divine Mercy. The second Sunday of Easter is also known at 'Low Sunday' of 'Thomas Sunday'.

PARISH CENTENARY RETREAT
