Thinking Skill	Activities			
Knowledge (Remember)	Write some facts about the plants in your garden or plants that live in certain habitats – eg a cactus in a desert.			
Comprehension (Understand)	<ul> <li>Make an alphabetical list of all the plants in your garden.</li> <li>List some of the jobs a gardener has to do in the garden during the year.</li> </ul>			
<b>Application</b> (Apply)	<ul> <li>Plant a bulb or some seeds and keep a short diary of how you look after it and how it grows.</li> <li>Help to look after your garden- take a picture of you gardening and write about some of the ways you have helped.</li> </ul>			
Analysis (Analyse)	<ul> <li>Draw and label the parts of a flower or tree.</li> <li>Complete an observational drawing or painting of some plants or flowers in your house or garden.</li> </ul>			
Synthesis (Create)	<ul> <li>Design and make a simple garden in a shoe box. It might have real plants and animals or have designe plants you have created yourself.</li> <li>Design your own garden and draw a plan of the fun features you would have if you could. Eg a sand pit.</li> </ul>			
<b>Evaluation</b> (Evaluate)	<ul> <li>Write a short story based on a famous plant story such as – Jack and the Beanstalk or The Enormous Turnip.</li> </ul>
