# **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

All children are expected to wear school uniform. Please ensure all items are labelled.

#### Summer Uniform:

Pale Blue Polo Shirt (School Logo optional)

Grey Trousers or Shorts with grey socks or

Pale Blue gingham dress with white socks

Navy v-neck Sweatshirt or Cardigan (School Logo optional)

Navy cap (School Logo optional)

We have noticed that PE kits continue to not follow school uniform expectations in quite a number of cases.

Please make sure that children are only wearing the following items for PE:

PE Kit:

Pale Blue Polo Shirt (School Logo optional) as for uniform above

Navy Sweatshirt or Cardigan as for uniform above (School Logo optional)

Navy Shorts or Joggers / leggings

Trainers

Children should not wear shorts / track suit bottoms which are sport branded or colours other than navy.

Children should not wear a top other than their cardigan / sweatshirt over their PE t-shirt.

Hair bobble: navy / black / grey / white / blue gingham in summer

No jewellery is to be worn, except for a simple watch. We advise that earrings are not worn for health and safety reasons, however should you allow your child to wear earrings, only small studs will be acceptable, which must be removed for PE.

Hair styles must not be extreme, and should be appropriate and safe for school activities with long hair tied up.

In response to recent, new Government guidance about school uniform, we will shortly be consulting with parents/carers and children about school uniform to ensure that we balance the need for wearing uniform with affordability and practicality. This will be done through an online survey soon.

We are also building up a stock of second hand uniform which will be available from the school office shortly. This provides a more cost-effective way to keep children looking smart, and also offers another opportunity to reduce our carbon footprint and be more eco-aware. There will be no expectation to purchase the second-hand uniform, but any donations would be greatly appreciated in return for any uniform taken. If you have any uniform, in good condition, that your child has outgrown, please send it into the school office. Thank you.
