Thinking Skill	Activities
Knowledge (Remember)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make an insect fact book including written facts and diagrams.
Comprehension (Understand)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make a list of food a mini-beast might eat.• Write a set of instructions to make a simple bug hotel.
Application (Apply)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draw or paint a mini-beast picture – it may contain real or bugs you have invented.• Draw or paint some symmetrical mini-beasts such as ladybirds or butterflies.
Analysis (Analyse)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete a mini-beast survey in your garden and record all the different bugs you find.• Write a simple poem about a mini-beast, it may be an acrostic poem eg A N T
Synthesis (Create)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Design and make a simple bug hotel. You may not be able to bring it into school if you have already placed it in your garden, so bring a picture. (Or write the instructions as above.)• Design and make your own mini-beast and give it a new name.
Evaluation (Evaluate)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write a letter or postcard home from a mini-beast on holiday or on an adventure.• Write a short story where the main character is a mini-beast – caterpillar, worm, and butterfly.
