A reminder that from September we have made some changes to the school uniform as outlined below. Thank you for your support so far in a positive start to implementing these changes. This term is a transition period, but we do expect that from January 2020, everything outlined below is followed.

The one aspect noted this week which has not been implemented as consistently is in relation to school bags. Please note that from January 2020, children should only bring a book bag into school in all classes except Year 6, where a small rucksack can be used. Our storage in school is limited and children do not need to be bringing lots to school so therefore a book bag is sufficient and more easily stored. Thank you in anticipation of your support.
