


Year 5: Spring Term <u>Lent/Easter - Giving:</u> <u>Sacrifice</u>



Lent is the season when Christians try to focus on giving. This helps us to identify with the complete sacrifice of Jesus which is remembered in the liturgy of Holy Week, especially the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday - Easter Sunday).
