



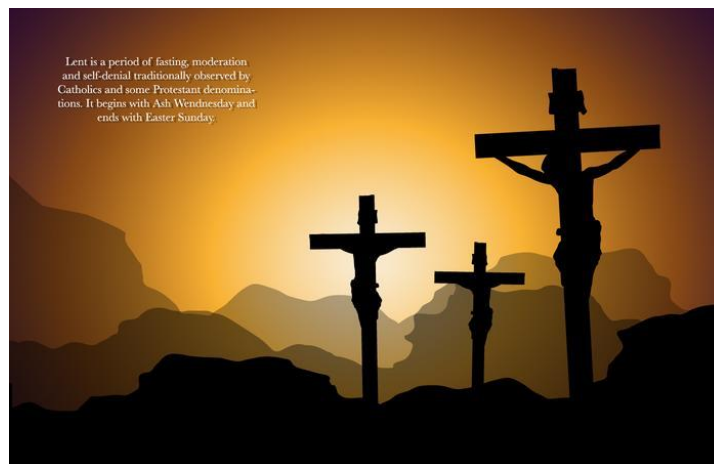
## Year 5: Spring Term
