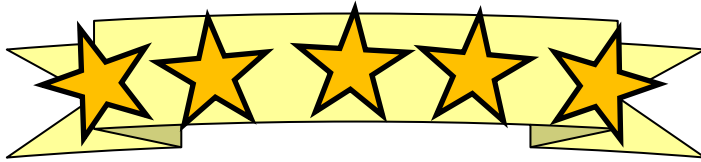

We would also love you to share a photo with us of you at the match! As you can see Clemency and Olivia had a great time last week!





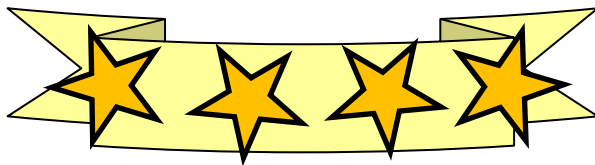
A message for our Year 6 children!

Mental Health Awareness Week



Next week is Mental Health Awareness Week, the UK's national week to raise awareness of mental health. The focus this year is on anxiety and there will be a range

of workshops and assemblies during the week.

The Schools Link Mental Health Team, who are based at Culcheth High School, will be delivering an 'Understanding and Recognising Anxiety' workshop with Y5 and 6. During the session the children will be exploring: The term 'mental health', anxious thoughts and the associated feelings, physical symptoms that affect our bodies and strategies that can be used to support us when we have these thoughts.

This is an interactive workshop and the children will be encouraged to relax and participate in group discussions whilst sharing their feelings and experiences. If you have any further queries please speak to your child's class teacher, who will be able to pass on any questions or concerns to the Schools Link Mental Health Team.
