COVID-19: ISOLATION RULES AND REPORTING

Please do not send your child into school if they have symptoms of COVID-19:

a high temperature

a new, continuous cough

a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Only your child must isolate if they have any of the above symptoms, but you must take them for a PCR test.

If PCR within 48 hours confirms a positive result, then they will remain in isolation to complete the 10 day period, but if negative, they can return to school.

If anyone in your household or a close contact tests positive, household members and close contacts will be asked to take a PCR test, but will only need to isolate if they themselves show symptoms or the test returns a positive result.

If your child is required to isolate due to symptoms or a positive test for COVID-19, please notify school immediately by telephone or email to: office@stvincentsprimary.org
