Theme: Seasons - Geography topic

You can complete as many of the tasks as you choose in the time given, but you must make sure that it is well presented work to share or display and show off your skills!

Thinking Skill	Activities
<b>Knowledge</b> (Remember)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Write a Seasons fact book with facts about each season.</li><li>• Make up a simple quiz about the Seasons.</li></ul>
<b>Comprehension</b> (Understand)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Draw or paint a picture, or make a collage using colours from all four Seasons or just one. For example use orange, yellow, brown, red, green in an Autumn collage or blue, white, grey, silver in a Winter collage.</li></ul>
<b>Application</b> (Apply)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Make an Autumn sculpture using twigs and other natural resources.</li><li>• Go on an Autumn scavenger hunt – collect or find all the items on the sheet.</li></ul>
<b>Analysis</b> (Analyse)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use your senses to list ideas and write an Autumn poem about the sights, smells, sounds, feelings and tastes of Autumn.</li></ul>
<b>Synthesis</b> (Create)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Design and make a shoe box environment of one of the four seasons.</li><li>• Take pictures of interesting things you notice about the changes in nature during Autumn. Make a</li></ul>
<b>Evaluation</b> (Evaluate)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Write a short story about one of the seasons with animals as characters. For example have squirrels as the characters in an Autumn story.</li></ul>

Please bring anything you complete on Autumn into school straight away to add to our display.  
Other seasonal work can be brought into school as it is completed.
