Composition	<ul> <li>Say a sentence out loud before writing it down</li> <li>Plan writing by saying what they are going to write about</li> <li>Read own writing aloud so that it can be heard by others and to check for sense</li> <li>Sequence sentences to form short narratives</li> <li>Use sequenced sentences in chronological order to recount an event /experience</li> </ul>
Transcription (Spelling)	<ul> <li>Spell unknown words using phonemes (sounds) Use the suffixes -ing, -ed, -er and - est where no change is needed in the spelling of root words</li> <li>Write from memory simple dictated sentences including the words taught so far</li> <li>Use letter names to show alternative spellings of the same phonemes</li> <li>Spell word that use suffixes for plurals or third person</li> <li>Spell the days of the week</li> </ul>
Handwriting and presentation	<ul> <li>Sit correctly at a table, holding a pencil comfortably and correctly</li> <li>Form the digits 0-9 Form lower case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place Name the letters of the alphabet in order</li> <li>Form capital letters</li> </ul>
