| Knowledge (Remember) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write about your favourite flower.• Make up a simple quiz about different habitats.• Research England and see if there are any plants that just grow here. |
| Comprehension (Understand) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draw a picture of your favourite plant or flower and label the different parts.• Draw your favourite animal in its natural habitat. |
| Application (Apply) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make a model of your favourite plant or animal in its natural habitat. |
| Analysis (Analyse) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draw a plan of your favourite animal in its natural habitat and how it survives there thinking about what it depends on.• Plant a seed and keep a diary as it grows to record the changes. |
| Synthesis (Create) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create your own flower in the style of Georgia O'Keeffe.• Design a new animal and the habitat in which it will live.• Draw, paint or make a model of a tree or flower. |
| Evaluation (Evaluate) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write an information leaflet about a habitat of your choice (Arctic, desert, rainforest, African plains) and the animals that live there. |
