REVISED DETAILS FOR WIDER RE-OPENING TO SOME YEAR GROUPS

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Council and Local Authority met again yesterday to review Warrington's position in relation to the wider re-opening of schools. Based on evidence shared by Cheshire and Merseyside Directors of Public Health, it has now been confirmed that schools should begin to open gradually, as previously planned, to Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 from **Monday 15**th **June**.

If you have informed us that your child is returning to school, please make sure that you have read the information already published on the website, and the summary within this letter.

Classes will return on the following revised dates as long as changes to published plans are not required:

Monday 15th June: Year 1 children return to school
Monday 22nd June: Reception children return to school
Monday 29th June: Year 6 children return to school

 All children of key workers or those who are vulnerable will continue to be able to access provision based on the need of each individual, as is currently the case. Please notify the school office using office@stvincentsprimary.org to let us know your needs for the following week by midday each Friday.

Staffing and groupings for Reception and Year 1 have not changed since previous information was published however, due to a significant increase in the number of key worker children now needing to return to school, this will impact on our plans for Year 6. We will therefore confirm groupings and staffing for Year 6 and further arrangements for other year groups not returning as soon as possible.

If you have decided that your child is not returning as outlined above, please be aware that due to this increase in the number of key worker children, we may now not have the flexibility to accommodate further increases in other year groups.

If your child has returned to school but is absent, you must notify us of their absence following normal procedures.

When dropping off and picking up your child, arrangements outlined in the guidance already published and shown on the attached map must be followed. The map shows where your child's group will be taught, their play zone for break and lunch time, where you should drop off in a morning and where you should wait at pick up time. Drop off and pick up times have been staggered to reduce the number of people on site at any time – you must ensure that these times are followed:

From Monday, all children in school must now return to wearing school uniform as outlined in the guidance already published. This can be winter uniform, summer uniform or PE kit but no tie should be worn at all and all clothing worn in school must be washed every day. We understand that children may have grown out of some items which cannot be replaced due to restrictions currently in place on retail, and should not be replaced since there are only a few weeks left of this academic year. We therefore accept that children may not always be wearing full school uniform but if this is the case, please ensure that an appropriate alternative is worn.

In order to reduce the risk of transmission, only the following items are allowed into school from home: water bottle, snack, lunchbox if having a packed lunch from home. NO OTHER BAGS, ITEMS OR EQUIPMENT SHOULD BE BROUGHT INTO SCHOOL. A reminder that all school lunches, free or paid, will be a packed lunch at this time, and no toast or juice will be available at break time, so your child must bring their own snack. Please ensure that snack and items in a packed lunch can be opened by your child without help.

Please be aware, that whilst plans in place meet all the current requirements of the Government and Local Authority, when children start to return we may find that plans need adapting or changing and as always, we will keep you informed of any changes as soon as possible.
