Thinking Skill	Activities
Knowledge (Remember)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• List some famous landmarks from around the UK• Draw a famous landmark and label it with what materials could have been used to build it.
Comprehension (Understand)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain what materials have been used in a famous UK landmark of your choice and why those materials were used.
Application (Apply)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Imagine you are the Queen's corgi and have travelled around Warrington, write a postcard home about the exciting things you have seen and done.
