



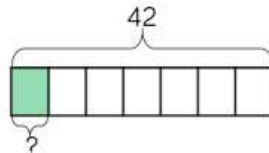

Find $\frac{1}{7}$ of 42



$$42 \div 7 = 6$$
$$\frac{1}{7} \text{ of } 42 \text{ is } 6$$

$\frac{1}{6}$ of 480

$\frac{1}{9}$ of 81 m
