NURSERY AND RECEPTION REJOICE CELEBRATION

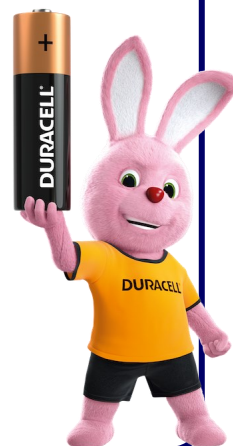

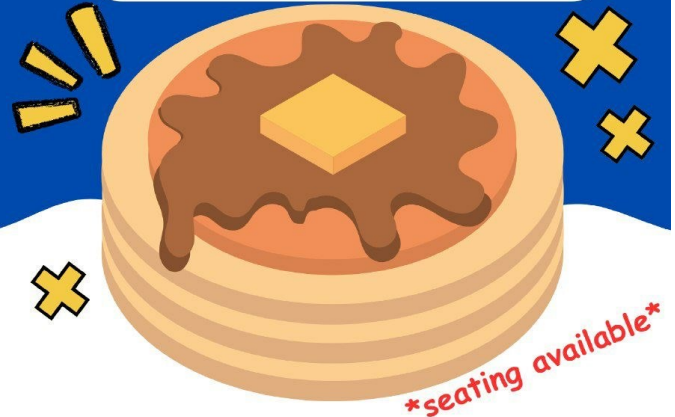
