Question One (1 Mark)

1 mark for a simple explanation

E.g. He had been waiting for it for a long time.

Question Two (1 Mark)

1 mark for circling the correct answer

he was not expecting to receive an experience voucher

Question Three (1 Mark)

1 mark for ticking the correct answer

it is large and heavy

Question Four (1 Mark)

1 mark for ticking the correct thought

'I'm not sure what to expect. It's making me nervous.'

Question Five (2 Marks)

1 mark for identifying and comparing the two opinions

E.g. Sonny was nervous but the narrator was excited.

2 marks for a more detailed response with supporting evidence from the text

E.g. We know that the narrator was very excited about the experience because he had been waiting for the day for a long time. However, Sonny was more nervous about the experience, and we know this from his cautious approach as he climbed into the basket.

Question Six (2 Marks)

1 mark for a simple response identifying the atmosphere

E.g. The scenery created a peaceful atmosphere.

2 marks for a more detailed response

E.g. The description of the sunrise creates a peaceful and tranquil atmosphere, which made the family feel so calm and in awe that they 'whispered' to each other.



Question Seven (2 Marks)

1 mark for each of the following impressions (maximum of 2 marks):

They were generous to take their children on this experience

They were appreciative of the experience

They felt lucky

They hadn't experienced things like this before

Question Eight (1 Mark)

1 mark for correctly matching all characters to their emotion

Narrator – excited

Sonny – apprehensive

Mum – amazed OR astonished

Dad – amazed OR astonished

Question Nine (1 Mark)

1 mark for circling the correct answer

elegant

Question Ten (1 Mark)

1 mark for correctly ordering all events

They receive a safety talk - **3**

The family admire the scenery from the sky - **4**

The family wake up early to travel to an airfield – **2**

The narrator begins to feel sad - **5**

It is the narrator's birthday - **1**
